The IWG was set the aims to provide guideline to improve the awareness on bat conservation by providing educational materials and procedures in common among the different parties.

- Provide simple guideline to improve the diffusion of awareness in the different school grades.

The group asked to EUROBATS members to send list of available materials in the different languages later archived in the EUROBATS work space, creating also a thesaurus to ordinate and search the materials.

The next step, during the AC23, will be to commonly create base materials for poster or pamphlet that will be available to download by educators from EUROBATS's web.

The materials should focus on preschool, kindergarten and primary schools. These first materials will be presented at the next MoP.
