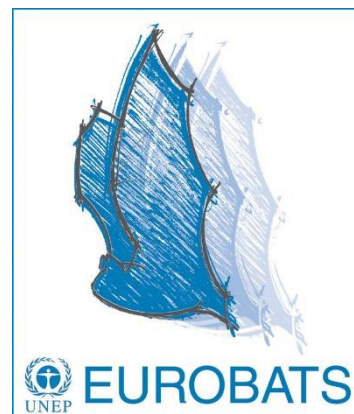


27th Meeting of the Advisory Committee

The hotel Holiday will also be the venue for AC27. There will be a delegates' workplace in the hotel, with a computer (with internet access) and a printer. Free WiFi is available in the hotel rooms as well as in the conference halls.

Transfer to the hotel:

Since most of the meeting participants are arriving at Sarajevo by plane, EUROBATS has organised a shuttle service between Sarajevo International Airport and the hotel. **Upon your arrival, please look out for the driver holding a sign with the EUROBATS logo or your name.**

For those arriving by bus or train, the central railway station as well as the central bus station are within a 15-minute-walk from the hotel (see the map below).

In case of any problems, please call the Secretariat at the number provided above.

Accommodation:

Participants will be accommodated at the hotel Holiday (see address above).

Currency:

The currency in Bosnia and Herzegovina is the Konvertible Mark (BAM). 1 EUR = approx. 1.95 BAM.

Electricity:

In Bosnia and Herzegovina, the power sockets are of type C and F. The standard voltage is **230 V** and the standard frequency is **50 Hz**.

Mobile phones:

The mobile phone network is well developed.

Time Zone:

Bosnia and Herzegovina is in the Central European Time zone, GMT +1. Please note that this will change to GMT +2 starting from March 26, 2023.

Climate:

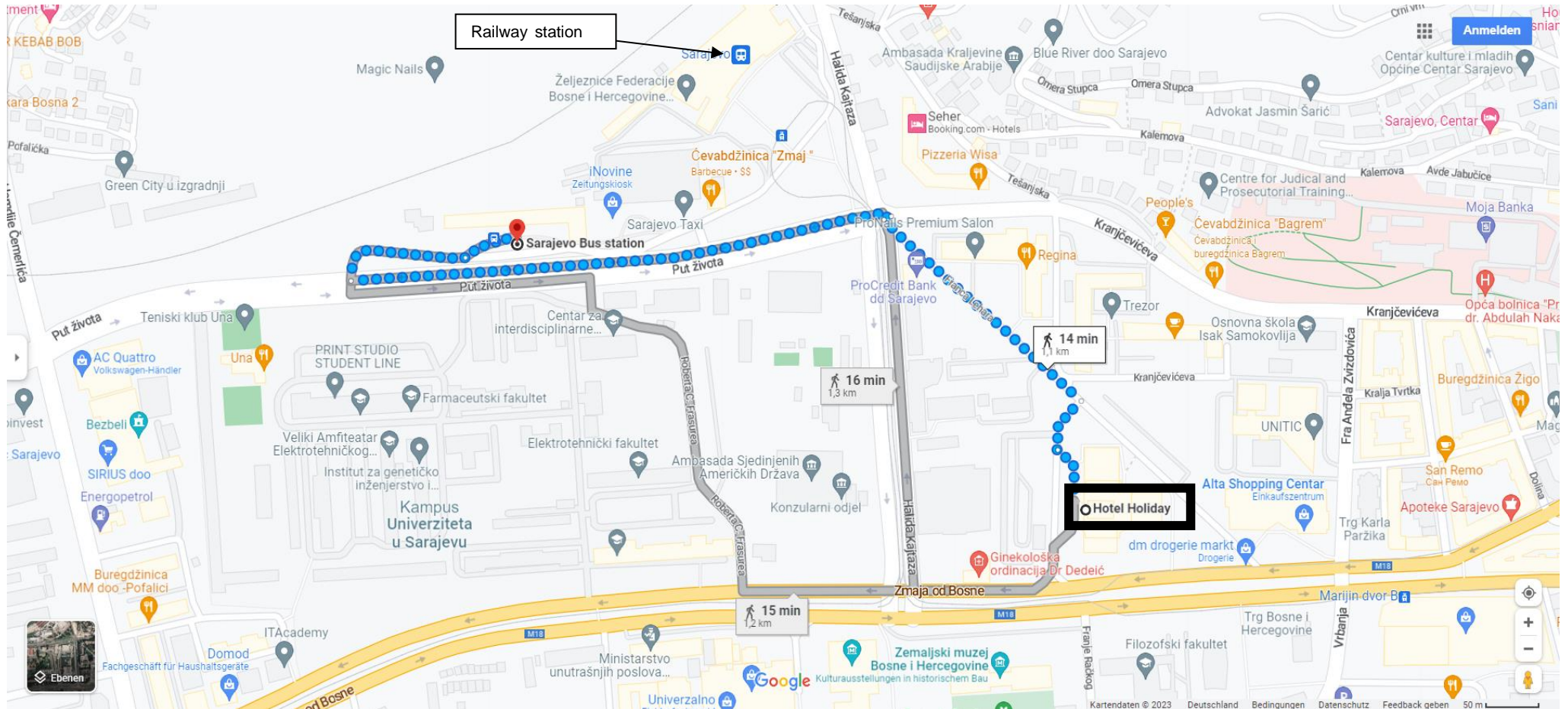
We are hoping for sunny and warm spring weather. However, please also pack appropriate clothing in case it gets chilly or rainy. Solid shoes are advisable for the excursion.

Security:

There are no particular security threats in Bosnia and Herzegovina. Nevertheless, please always bear the certificate with you, which identifies you as a UN delegate. Please contact the Secretariat immediately in case of any problems.

Insurance:

Participants are themselves responsible for any kind of health and travel insurance.



COVID-19 Prevention and Risk Mitigation Measures¹

1. What you should know before arrival

a. COVID-19 Vaccination Status

The vaccination against COVID 19 is no longer mandatory but it is highly recommended to be vaccinated for your own safety. The Secretariat will not be able to cover the costs of a hospitalisation. Thus, being vaccinated is the best way to avoid strong symptoms which may lead to a hospitalisation.

Please check with your airline if a test or a proof of vaccination is needed before boarding.

b. Arrival into Bosnia and Herzegovina

Currently, travellers can enter Bosnia and Herzegovina without the need of vaccination or immunity certificates, or any kind of test or quarantine obligation.
