#### **Transfer Airport/Train Station/Hotel:**

A shuttle bus/car will bring you from and to the airport/train station. Please look out for a person with a EUROBATS sign.

#### **Location:**

The hotel is located outside the city centre of Prague. A shopping centre and the underground station "Chodov" can be reached in 8 minutes by bus. From there it takes another 12 minutes by underground to the city centre. A bus stop is located in front of the hotel with busses circulating every 15 or 20 minutes depending on the time of the day (Bus No. 115, stop "Městský archiv" and underground Metro Line C, stop "Chodov" to/from the city centre).

#### **Hotel Facilities ([www.tophotel.cz/en](http://www.tophotel.cz/en)):**

The hotel has an excellent wellness centre (open from 8:00 – 22:00 hrs) including indoor swimming pool, spa, sauna, whirlpool and much more as well as a fitness centre. Also in- and outdoor tennis courts are available. If you would like to use these facilities, please don't forget to bring your swimsuit/sports dress.

**Restaurants:**

There are several restaurants and bars with reasonable rates available in the hotel.

**Climate:**

We are hoping for sunny autumn weather. Nevertheless you should be prepared for rainy weather too.

**Field trip:**

No special equipment is needed for the field trip on Sunday 19 September. Solid shoes are always useful.

**Security:**

Prague is a very safe city. Like in all big cities there is a certain risk of pickpockets. You are advised to always bear the UN Certificate with you, which identifies you as a UN delegate. Please contact the Secretariat immediately in case of any problem.

**Currency:**

The currency is the Czech Koruna (CZK). 1 Euro corresponds to approximately 25 Koruna. A cash exchange counter is available inside the hotel. A cash dispenser is located at Chodov shopping centre. Within the hotel you can also pay with Euro.

**Insurance:**

You are yourself responsible for any kind of health and travel insurance.
