WALLONIE (BELGIUM) REPORT ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE AGREEMENT ON BATS - UPDATE TO THE YEAR 2003 –

Political action of the Ministry of Region Wallonne for bats conservation is full described on site: http://www.eurobats.org/PartyReports/Belgium/Belgium(Wallonie).htm). Since 7th Meeting of the Advisory Committee in May 2002, main implementations are made in following directions:

1/ Protection of winter roosts

Region count now 136 underground sites protected for bat populations – 67 RND (State Natural Reserves) & 69 CSIS (Underground Sites of Scientific Interest) with state agreement – 83 are in N2000 areas. It's a progress of 13% with regard on year 2002. About ten new projects for the protections of caves or other types of underground sites is to take shape.

2/ <u>Protection of the reproduction roosts by the operation "Lofts and steeples" made on the Communes level</u>

Today, 113 Communes are concerned and represented 825 buildings protected who will be managed for wild fauna, especially for bats - 106 Communes signed a convention with the Ministry. It's a progress of more than 7% with regard on year 2002, and future perspective is ever positive.

3/ Publicity and promoting awareness

- The 6th Bat Night was organised the 31 August 2001 in 28 different places and concerned more than 2.500 participants.
