Overview on voluntary contributions received in the financial year 2010



- Finland: 1,770 EUR were spent for the Romanian project on Bat data for sites of interest.
- France: 6,255 EUR (contribution received in December 2010) were allocated and spent in 2009 already for the production of the French version of EUROBATS Publication Series No. 4, the EUROBATS leaflet in French and a French version of the forestry leaflet.
- 8,850 EUR have been received in December 2010 as support for the Year of the Bat campaign. 6,128 EUR have already been spent in 2010 for the logo, website, newsletter and other promotional material as well as consultancy costs.
- Germany: 22,655 EUR received in 2010 were spent as following:
- 6,186 EUR for a bat conservation project in Romania (Bat data for sites of interest) conducted in 2010.
- 3,500 EUR for a bat conservation project in Tunisia (Bats in Bou Hedma National Park) was started in 2010.
- Germany funded travel costs for four delegates from the Middle East to the AC 15 meeting with 2,879 EUR and travel costs for six delegates to the sixth Meeting of Parties with 4,782 EUR.
- 25,221 EUR received in December 2010 for “Year of the Bat” campaign material. The funds were only spent in early 2011.
- Luxembourg: 4,425 EUR received in 2010 were spent on EPI project in Romania (inventory of *R. euryale*).
- Netherlands: 209 EUR have been spent for reference material and 128 EUR proportional for the shipping of Bat Night Posters in 2010.
- Norway: 8,531.52 EUR received in 2010 were spent for travel costs for delegates from countries with economies in transition to the 6th Session of the Meeting of Parties.
